9 games which were all 7 minutes long in which we lost 2, drew 2 and won 5.

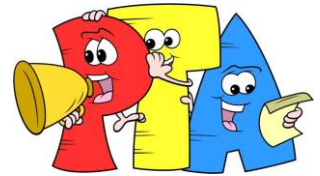
